### **School Traffic**

We need to slow down and watch out for each other. U-turns around the schools are dangerous and there is a reason they are not allowed. Please report bad driving that you witness to your school and make a traffic service request. Try arriving a bit earlier at the school to avoid congestion. Contact your school to find out what they recommend for proper drop off and pick up areas. I have met with and attended meetings with both the CBE and Separate school boards. Some programs will be shared soon to encourage fewer cars driving to the schools.

If your children are old enough, encourage them to walk or bike to school. There is a great pathway system that can be used.

### **Shortcutting Traffic**

Evergreen continues to be a short cutting area of drivers traveling from other areas to get to Fish Creek Blvd. and 37th Street. Please be wary of this when getting around Evergreen. Hopefully when the SWRR is complete this will diminish somewhat.

### **Speed**

I still am witnessing my own neighbours and community residents drive too quickly on our own streets! Evergreen still ranks high with the number of kids in the area. Why do you think we will be getting four schools?

Slow down! Don't let your inattention and bad habit be something that changes someone else's life forever.

### **Alleyways**

Got an alleyway in need of gravel or there are too many ruts? This past winter has caused some deep ruts in places and spring rains will cause some damage on gravel alleyways. ### What are CECA and SECA and who do I belong to?

CECA is the Calgary Evergreen Community Association and SECA is the Shawnee-Evergreen Community Association. Calgary Evergreen is all of the roads that start with Ever (but don't end in green). For example, Everoak, Eversyde, Everridge, etc. Shawnee-Evergreen is the area of Shawnee Slopes, and also Evergreen Estates where all the roads start with Evergreen.

In future newsletters I will go into some history of CECA and SECA and how Evergreen Estates remained part of SECA.

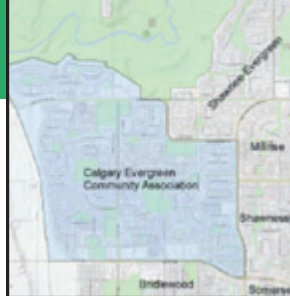
To belong to either of the community associations you will need to purchase a \$20 membership that is good for the immediate family in one household. See the website [www.myceca.ca/membership](http://www.myceca.ca/membership) to purchase yours. Anyone is welcome to purchase a membership with CECA but only those that live in the area will be able vote at the AGM and serve on the Board of Directors.

### What is the Evergreen Residents Association?

When Evergreen was first developed the developer put in place a Home-Owners Association and this would become the Evergreen Residents Association. This was affixed to title of some of the homes in Evergreen to pay for landscaping of some of the parks and entry gardens. This was done for only half of Evergreen as the other half was developed by another developer that did not do a HOA. After a few years the developer turned over the maintenance to homeowners in Evergreen that formed the board of the ERA. Thank you to those who are in the ERA and pay for the landscaping that provide for nice entry gardens for everyone to enjoy.

### What's the Difference between the Evergreen Resident's Association and the Calgary Evergreen Community Association?

Although we both share the same boundaries, for the most part, we provide very different benefits to you and the community.

#### Evergreen Resident's Association (ERA) \$105/year fee

The ERA is a separate entity from the Calgary Evergreen Community Association (CECA). While the community association plays a significant role in the provision of services and advocacy towards the City of Calgary on behalf of the greater community, **the ERA was established solely to maintain the community entrance features and feature parks which are not owned by the City.**
